He received an advanced diploma from St. Clair College, Windsor, Ontario. Before serving in Puerto Rico, James served in the Dominican Republic for three years as a communication specialist. Prior to him heading to the mission field, he served on two mission trips to the Dominican Republic (June 2014 and June 2015) and one mission trip to Nicaragua (March 2013). He also volunteered with Bethesda Lutheran Communities Disability Services and with the after-school program at First Lutheran Christian Academy, Windsor. In his free time, James enjoys volunteering at his church, sports, hiking and spending time with friends.
