Rev. Hanson received both his Master of Divinity (1996) and his Master of Sacred Theology (1998) from Concordia Seminary, St. Louis. He is currently working on his doctorate (Ph.D.) degree at Concordia Seminary, St. Louis, through their Module Program in Doctrinal Theology.

Carl is married to Chenhsi and together they have three daughters, Emma, Andrea and Lydia. Chenhsi, a trained Chinese/English translator, is actively involved in the congregation as well as the school where Andrea and Lydia attend and a local orphanage. Family hobbies include reading a good book and enjoying a hike on one of the many hiking

trails in the Seoul area.
