Since 2000, he has served on mission trips to Uganda, Sudan, Kenya, Ghana, Haiti and Belize. He also is a Lutheran Early Response Team (LERT) volunteer and has assisted with disaster-recovery efforts in Louisiana, Illinois, Arkansas and Alabama. In his free time, Gary enjoys fishing, hiking and camping.

Sue was born in Lockport, Ill., and has an early childhood education degree from Waubensee Community College in northern Illinois. Among other jobs, she has worked as a teacher at the preschool of Lord of Life Lutheran Church, Elburn, Ill., where she and Gary are members. At Lord of Life, she oversaw the Comfort Dog ministry and served on the church’s mission board. She also is a LERT volunteer and has responded to disasters in Illinois and Louisiana. In her free time, she enjoys fishing and sewing.
