Before serving as an international missionary, Micah served as a dual parish pastor at Bethlehem Lutheran Church and Hope Lutheran Church, both located in Milwaukee, Wis., from 2006-2014.

Robin was born in Versailles, Mo., and baptized and confirmed at Grace Lutheran Church in Versailles. She graduated from Northwest Missouri State University, Maryville, in 2008, with a bachelor's degree in office information systems and financial computing. Micah and Robin enjoy spending time with their four children, Samuel, Elizabeth, David and

Lydia. The family enjoys bike rides, wiffle ball, family gatherings and the occasional swim.
